

Fishing Fire Rules

If you're planning to fish at Crystal Lakes, it's good to know where fires are and aren't allowed. Small, contained fires are permitted only in designated fire rings or grills around the lake.

Open fires along the shoreline or in random spots are not allowed, mainly to protect the property and keep everyone safe. So if you want to warm up or cook while you fish, just be sure to use the approved fire areas and follow posted guidelines.
